***A Discussion with Dr. Leana Wen
Baltimore City Health Commissioner***

Dr. Leana Wen, Commissioner of Health in Baltimore City, will speak at Brown Memorial Park Avenue Presbyterian Church about how the faith community and wider community can alleviate suffering due to the opioid crisis, including reducing the stigma around addiction and treating it as a disease. - 30-minute talk by Dr. Wen and a demonstration of how to use naloxone (also known as Narcan)—a drug that can reverse the effects of an opioid overdose.
